By Mr. Raposa of Somerset, petition of Manuel Raposa, Jr., that the Registrar of Motor Vehicles be authorized to suspend licenses of the operators of motor vehicles for improper conduct. Public Safety.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE REGISTRAR MAY SUSPEND AN OPERATOR'S LICENSE FOR IMPROPER CONDUCT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (b) of section 22 of chapter 90 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 174 of the acts of 1971, is
3 hereby further amended by inserting after the first sentence the
4 following sentence: — The registrar may also suspend or revoke
5 the license of any operator, after due hearing, for any cause
6 which he may deem sufficient.
