**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTIFICATION FOR A POSITION IN THE  
LABOR SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 18A of chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

3 Whenever the name of a person has been certified from an  
4 eligible list for a position in the Labor Service and he refuses  
5 to accept temporary or permanent employment after having  
6 previously expressed a willingness to accept such employment,  
7 or whenever he fails to respond to a notice of certification, his  
8 name shall be removed from the eligible list for a municipal  
9 department unless a satisfactory explanation of the refusal or  
10 failure to respond is given in writing to the Director within five  
11 days from the date of certification; provided, however, that no  
12 person shall in any case be eligible for further certification for  
13 a department if on the occasion of three such certifications he  
14 refuses to accept employment or at the termination of the two  
15 year period.
