AN ACT PROHIBITING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION FROM CHARGING PARKING FEES AT BEACHES UNDER THE CONTROL OF SAID COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or general law to
2 the contrary, the metropolitan district commission shall not
3 charge parking fees at any beaches under the control of said
4 commission.
