

By Mr. Frazier of Braintree, petition of Robert E. Frazier and others (by vote of the town) that the town of Braintree be authorized to use a portion of the Pond Street Cemetery and South Parish Cemetery to widen Pond Street in said town. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BRAINTREE TO USE A PORTION OF THE POND STREET CEMETERY AND SOUTH PARISH CEMETERY TO WIDEN POND STREET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of widening Pond Street in the Town of
2 Braintree, said town is hereby authorized in accordance with the
3 provisions of section forty-one of chapter one hundred and
4 fourteen of the General Laws, to use a portion of Pond Street
5 Cemetery, in said town, consisting of a strip of land containing
6 about four thousand three hundred and forty-seven square feet
7 bounded and described as follows: — Beginning at a point on the
8 street face of a granite post located at the north-western corner
9 of the Town of Braintree Pond Street Cemetery, said post being
10 the north-western of two posts marking the Cemetery driveway
11 entrance from Pond Street, the said post being also on the
12 south-western line of Pond Street as defined by an existing
13 masonry wall running along the north-eastern boundary of the
14 said cemetery;

15 Thence, South 68 degrees 30 minutes and 50 seconds East,
16 following along the said masonry wall, for a distance of 276.20
17 feet to a point on the line dividing the Town of Braintree Pond
18 Street Cemetery from the Town of Braintree South Parish
19 Cemetery;

20 Thence South 4 degrees 30 minutes and 20 seconds West,

21 following along the said dividing line, for a distance of 17.35 feet
22 to a point;

23 Thence north-westerly by a curve-radius 860.00 feet to the
24 right for a distance of 31.15 to a point;

25 Thence North 67 degrees 55 minutes and 40 seconds West for
26 a distance of 228.89 feet to a point;

27 Thence continuing north-westerly by a curve-radius 700.00
28 feet to the left for a distance of 17.57 feet to a point on a chain
29 link fence marking the western boundary of the Town of
30 Braintree Pond Street Cemetery;

31 Thence North 7 degrees and 15 minutes East, following along
32 the said chain link fence for a distance of 14.99 feet, more or
33 less, to the point of beginning.
