Piro for an investigation by a special commission (including members of the General Court) relative to funding the state employees retirement system, report recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 6040) ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on public service be authorized  
2 to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of  
3 making an investigation and study of the subject matter of the  
4 investigation and study proposed by current house document  
5 numbered 2360, relative to funding the state retirement system.

6 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state  
7 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the  
8 commonwealth and may expend for expert, clerical and other  
9 services and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

10 Said committee shall report to the general court the results of  
11 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, to-  
12 gether with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommen-  
13 dations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house  
14 of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of January,  
15 nineteen hundred and seventy-four.
