**AN ACT PROVIDING THAT EYE ENUCLEATION MAY BE PERFORMED
BY TRAINED TECHNICIANS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Subsection (d) of section 10 of chapter 113 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 653 of the acts of 1971, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — Notwithstanding subsection
5 (b) of section thirteen, the donor may designate in his will, card
6 or other document of gift the surgeon or physician to carry out
7 the appropriate procedures; provided, however, that eye enu-
8 cleations may be performed also by a technician who has success-
9 fully completed a course of training acceptable to the Eye Bank
10 of the Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary.
