Chap. 10. AN ACT DIRECTING THE COUNTY OF PLYMOUTH TO REIMBURSE THE CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER OF THE THIRD DISTRICT COURT OF PLYMOUTH ON ACCOUNT OF MONEY STOLEN FROM HIS OFFICE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The county of Plymouth is hereby authorized and directed to reimburse the chief probation officer of the third district court of Plymouth in the amount of sixty-one dollars and nine cents, which sum was the amount stolen and not recovered in a burglary of the courthouse of said court during the night of March third, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven.

Chap. 11. AN ACT PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN A NOISY MANNER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 16 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 239 of the acts of 1965, is hereby further amended by striking out the fifth sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — No person operating a motor vehicle shall sound a bell, horn or other device, nor in any manner operate such motor vehicle so as to make a harsh, objectionable or unreasonable noise, nor permit any unreasonable amount of smoke to escape from such vehicle.

Chap. 12. AN ACT REQUIRING APPOINTING AUTHORITIES TO KEEP ON FILE WRITTEN APPROVAL OF LEAVES OF ABSENCE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The first paragraph of section 46E of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 143 of the acts of 1967, is hereby further amended by striking out the third sentence and inserting in place thereof the following two sentences: — A copy of such written approval shall be kept on file by the appointing authority who shall, upon request, forward a copy of said written approval to the commission or director. In the case of a city or town, the appointing authority shall forward forthwith a copy of the written approval of such leave of absence to the city or town clerk, as the case may be.

Chap. 13. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BRISTOL COUNTY TO EXPEND A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADVERTISING THE RECREATIONAL ADVANTAGES OF SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter sixty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-six is hereby repealed.
