The committee on Rules, to whom was referred the Order (filed by Messrs. Richard F. Finnigan of Boston, MacDonald of Boston and White of Boston) relative to the appointment of a special committee of the House to make an investigation and study of traffic control, transportation planning and coordination at the new University of Massachusetts in Boston located in the Dorchester district of the city of Boston (House, No. 6291), report that the same ought to be adopted.

1 *Ordered*, That a special committee, to consist of ten members
2 of the house of representatives to be designated by the speaker
3 thereof, be authorized to make an investigation and study rela-
4 tive to the problem of the residents of Dorchester in particular
5 and the commonwealth in general caused by the lack of traffic
6 control, transportation planning and coordination at the new
7 University of Massachusetts in Boston at Dorchester. Said com-
8 mittee shall be provided with quarters in the state house or else-
9 where, may hold hearings, may require by summons the atten-
10 dance and testimony of witnesses and the production of books
11 and papers, may travel within the commonwealth, and may ex-
12 pend for clerical and other assistance and expenses such sums as
13 may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the
14 house of representatives the results of its investigation and study,
15 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legisla-
16 tion necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing
17 the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or
18 before June first, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
