**AN ACT ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR THE TYPE OF SPEEDOMETER
INSTALLED IN CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 7 of chapter 90
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 sentence added by chapter 69 of the acts of 1965 the following
4 sentence: – Every motor vehicle registered in the commonwealth
5 shall be equipped with a speedometer, and such speedometer
6 shall not register or indicate a mile per hour speed greater than
7 eighty-five miles per hour.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section seven of chapter
2 ninety of the General Laws, inserted by section one of this act,
3 shall apply only to motor vehicles manufactured for the model
4 year nineteen hundred and seventy-five and for subsequent
5 model years.
