The committee on Ways and Means, to whom were referred the Bill authorizing the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to establish a branch office for the Registry of Motor Vehicles in the town of Norwood (House, No. 1065); the Bill decreasing the licensing fees paid by mobile home owners sixty-five years of age or over (House, No. 4060); the Bill authorizing the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to establish a branch office for the Registry of Motor Vehicles in the city of Gardner (House, No. 4561); the Bill authorizing the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to establish a branch office for the Registry of Motor Vehicles in the town of Middleborough (House, No. 4776); the Bill allowing the spouse of handicapped persons to register the motor vehicle in his own name and still maintain special plates (House, No. 5492); and the Bill concerning safety defects in motor vehicles (House, No. 6367), report recommending that the accompanying resolve (House, No. 6469) ought to pass.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF PUBLIC SAFETY RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ESTABLISH A BRANCH OFFICE FOR THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF NORWOOD AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That the executive office of public safety through
2 its registry of motor vehicles is hereby authorized and directed to
3 make an investigation of current house documents number 1065,
4 authorizing the registrar of motor vehicles to establish a branch
5 office for the registry of motor vehicles in the town of Norwood;
6 4060, decreasing the licensing fees paid by mobile home owners
7 sixty-five years of age or over; 4561, authorizing the registrar of
8 motor vehicles to establish a branch office for the registry of
9 motor vehicles in the city of Gardner; 4776, authorizing the
10 registrar of motor vehicles to establish a branch office for the
11 registry of motor vehicles in the town of Middleborough; 5492,
12 allowing the spouse of handicapped persons to register the motor
