AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF THE LOWELL DISTRICT COURT TO DESIGNATE ONE OF HIS ASSISTANT CLERKS AS ASSISTANT CLERK IN CHARGE OF SIX MAN JURY SESSIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The tenth paragraph of Section 10 of Chapter 218 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in Section 1 of Chapter 75 of the
3 Acts of 1973, is hereby amended by striking out the line reading
4 "Third District Court of Eastern Middlesex" and inserting in
5 place thereof the following: —

6 Third District Court of Eastern Middlesex, and District Court
7 of Lowell.
