RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE REGULATION OF THE LOCATION AND OPERATION OF ELECTRIC UTILITY GENERATION AND TRANSMISSION FACILITIES AND OTHER MATTERS.

2 Chapter 78 of the Resolves of 1971, and most recently revived
3 and continued by Chapter 1 of the Resolves of Nineteen Hun-
4 dred and Seventy-Three, in the course of its investigation and
5 study, shall consider the subject matter of the current House
6 Document #3663, providing for legislation to provide for ade-
7 quate notice of proposed crossing of public ways by transmission
8 lines.
