RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO BRANCH OFFICES BEING ESTABLISHED IN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of three
2 members of the Senate, to be appointed by the Senate President,
3 five members of the House of Representatives, to be appointed
4 by the Speaker of the House, and three members to be appointed
5 by the Governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making
6 an investigation and study of current House document numbered
7 5001, establishing branch offices of the Department of the
8 Secretary of State in the cities of Worcester, Springfield and New
9 Bedford.

10 Said Commission shall report to the General Court the results
11 of the investigation and study and its recommendations, if any,
12 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
13 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
14 the House of Representatives on or before the 3rd Wednesday of
15 January, 1974.
