AN ACT REQUIRING THE SELLER OF GOODS FOUND TO BE DEFECTIVE
TO TRANSPORT THE SAME FOR REPAIR UNDER A WARRANTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Chapter 106 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 2-318 the following section: —

3 *Section 2-318A.* A seller of goods found to be defective, if
4 such goods are subject to a warranty providing for the repair
5 thereof, shall, at the request of the buyer, prepare such goods for
6 transport and shall transport the same for repair to the warrantor
7 or to a person designated by said warrantor.
