AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING SEASONAL LOBSTER PERMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 38 of chapter 130 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the ninth
3 sentence, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 861 of the acts of
4 1970, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —
5 Such a permit shall be issued to full time students only, after
6 such verification of student status as the director may determine,
7 and shall allow the holder to take and sell lobster during the
8 period June fifteen to September fifteen and shall limit the
9 holder to the use of not more than twenty-five pots.
