AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NATICK TO PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO DIAL HELP, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Natick is hereby authorized to pay
2 from the current tax levy to Dial Help, Inc. a sum not to exceed
3 one thousand dollars for services rendered to said town through
4 the youth and human resources committee in the year nineteen
5 hundred and seventy-two, payment for which is legally unen-
6 forceable against said town.

1 SECTION 2. No bill shall be approved by the accountant of
2 said town for payment or paid by the treasurer thereof under
3 authority of this act unless and until a certificate has been signed
4 and filed with said town accountant, stating under the penalties
5 of perjury that the services for which said bill has been submitted
6 were ordered by an official or an employee of said town and that
7 such services were rendered to said town, or both.

1 SECTION 3. Any person who knowingly files a certificate
2 required by section two which is false and who thereby receives
3 payment for services rendered to said town, shall be punished by
4 imprisonment for not more than one year or by a fine of not
5 more than three hundred dollars, or both.
