The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Local Affairs is hereby au-
2 thorized to sit during the recess of the general court for the
3 purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject mat-
4 ter of current house document numbered 7212, that the city of
5 Lawrence be authorized to establish a department of community
6 development in said city. Said committee shall be provided with
7 quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may
8 travel within the commonwealth, and may expend for clerical
9 and other services and expenses such sums as may be appropri-
10 ated therefor. Said committee shall report to the general court
11 the results of its investigation and study, and its recommenda-
12 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
13 such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the
14 clerk of the house of representatives on or before the last
15 Wednesday of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
