Substituted by the House, on motion of Mr. Businger of Brookline, for a report of the committee on Urban Affairs, ought not to pass, on the recommitted petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 2821) of Sumner Z. Kaplan, Jack H. Backman, Jon Rotenberg, James Segel, John A. Businger and others for legislation to regulate the conversion of controlled rental units into condominiums.

1 *Ordered*, That the committee on local affairs authorized
2 (under the provisions of an order, see House, No. 5937) to make
3 an investigation and study of house document numbered 1570 of
4 1972, relative to the control of rents and evictions in certain
5 cities and towns, shall, in the course of its investigation and
6 study, consider the subject matter of current house documents
7 numbered 2821, regulating the conversion of controlled rental
8 units into condominiums; 3602, regulating the conditions under
9 which rent control property may be converted to condominium
10 use; and 3778, relative to restricting conversion of controlled
11 rental units into condominiums.

The amendments recommended by the Committee on Education and Labor are as follows:
