AN ACT DESIGNATING THE SWIMMING POOL ON TREMONT STREET IN THE CITY OF MELROSE AS THE LAWRENCE W. LLOYD SWIMMING POOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The swimming pool on Tremont Street in the city of Melrose
- 2 shall be designated as the Lawrence W. Lloyd swimming pool in
- 3 memory of Lawrence W. Lloyd, a former mayor of said city. A
- 4 suitable marker bearing said designation shall be attached thereto
- 5 by the metropolitan district commission.
