**AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING CERTAIN VIOLATIONS OF THE STATE
SANITARY CODE.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 127A of Chapter 111, as most recently amended by
2 Chapter 261 of the Acts of 1971, is hereby further amended by
3 adding the following sentences at the end of the first paragraph:
4 Said code or a supplement thereto shall designate those condi-
5 tions which, when found to exist upon inspection of residential
6 premises, shall be deemed to endanger or materially impair the
7 health or safety of persons occupying the premises. This designa-
8 tion shall not be construed as prohibiting an inspector or other
9 authorized person from certifying that any other violation or
10 combination or series of violations of the Code or other appli-
11 cable laws, ordinances, by-laws, rules or regulations may en-
12 danger or materially impair the health or safety of said persons
13 when such certification is otherwise appropriate.
