RESOLUTIONS COMMENDING WILLIAM H. GALVIN, SUPERINTENDENT
OF SCHOOLS OF THE TOWN OF CANTON.

1 *Whereas*, The new Middle School in the Town of Canton will
2 be named the William H. Galvin School at dedication exercises to
3 be held on September the thirtieth of the current year in honor
4 of William H. Galvin, Superintendent of Schools in said Town;
5 and

6 *Whereas*, Superintendent Galvin, a native of Canton, attended
7 St. John's School and Canton High School and graduated from
8 Boston College; and

9 *Whereas*, His entire teaching career has been centered in
10 Canton, having been appointed in 1935, a teacher at the Canton
11 High School, in 1943 Principal of the Crane School, in 1950
12 Principal of the Hemenway School, in 1954 Principal of the Dean
13 S. Luce School, in 1958 Assistant Superintendent of Schools and
14 in 1959 Superintendent of Schools; and

15 *Whereas*, During his term, there has been built a new addition
16 at a high school and the following new schools, John F.
17 Kennedy, the Lt. Peter Hanson School and the Middle School;
18 and

19 *Whereas*, In addition to his many exacting duties, he has found
20 time to be active in community, civic, charitable and educational
21 organizations; therefore be it

22 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts House of Representatives
23 congratulates William H. Galvin, Superintendent of Schools on
24 the occasion of having the Middle School named in his honor and
25 extends to him its best wishes for continued success and
26 happiness; and be it further

27 *Resolved*, That a copy of these resolutions be forwarded by
28 the Secretary of the Commonwealth to William H. Galvin.
