## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO GRANT AN ANNUITY TO EVA WESTERGREN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provisions of law  
2 and for the purpose of promoting the public good and in  
3 consideration of the long and meritorious service of William H.  
4 Westergren, former Fire Inspector in the Fire Department, who  
5 died August 25, 1964, said city may grant to Eva Westergren  
6 widow of William H. Westergren an annuity under Section 95A  
7 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws of Massachusetts from  
8 September 15, 1973. The annuity provided by this section shall  
9 be in lieu of any other annuity or pension payable to said widow  
10 under any other general or special law.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance  
2 during the current year by the City of Springfield.

As an act of expediency, the Board of Directors of the  
Company has approved the plan and the Board of Directors  
has authorized the Board of Directors to execute the same.
