RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ENFORCEABILITY OF THE PROVISIONS OF LAW RESTRICTING THE WEIGHTS OF VEHICLES UPON PUBLIC WAYS.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission, established by chapter
2 eight of the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-three and
3 amended by chapter fifty-five of the resolves of nineteen hun-
4 dred and seventy-three, shall, in the course of its investigation
5 and study, consider the subject matter of current house docu-
6 ments numbered 7610, further regulating the penalties and pun-
7 ishment for overloaded vehicles, and 7611, further regulating the
8 overloading of certain commercial vehicles.
