## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO INCUR DEBT FOR PURPOSE OF PURCHASING DEPARTMENTAL EQUIPMENT FOR A TERM NOT EXCEEDING FIVE YEARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Clause (d) of section 16 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in Chapter 367 of the Acts of 1965, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting after the word "years", in Line 7, the words: — and
- 4 for the purpose of purchasing departmental equipment for a term
- 5 not exceeding five years.
