

SECTION 1. Chapter seven hundred and seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-four is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The so-called Memorial drive extension from Memorial drive and Ash street in the city of Cambridge to Arsenal street in the town of Watertown, including that part of North Beacon street which lies between the two sections of Charles River road, shall be known and designated as the Charles W. Greenough Boulevard, in memory of Charles W. Greenough, the late commissioner and associate commissioner of the metropolitan district commission, and suitable tablets and markers bearing said designation shall be erected and maintained along said boulevard by said commission.

SECTION 3. The section of Charles River road from Arsenal street to Galen street in the town of Watertown which was designated as Charles W. Greenough Boulevard by chapter seven hundred and seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-four shall hereafter be known and designated as Charles River road.

Chap. 614. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ASHLAND TO TAKE A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND BY EMINENT DOMAIN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The town of Ashland is hereby authorized to take by eminent domain under the provisions of chapter seventy-nine or chapter eighty A of the General Laws, for municipal purposes, the whole or any part of the approximately two-acre parcel of land which lies between the southerly side line of Front Street and the railroad tracks, in the general vicinity of the town library in the town of Ashland, said land owned now or formerly by the Penn Central Transportation Company and bounded and described as follows:

NORTHERLY along Front Street 441 ft. more or less;

EASTERLY 93 ft. more or less;

SOUTHERLY along the northerly side line of the Boston and Albany Railroad bed 641 ft. more or less;

WESTERLY along land of the Town of Ashland 82 ft. more or less;

NORTHERLY along land of the Community National Bank 165 ft. more or less; and

WESTERLY along said land 55 ft. more or less to a point of beginning.

Chap. 615. AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW RESTRICTING THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS.
