

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to immediately repeal the law relative to the construction and maintenance of sewage disposal systems, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section one hundred and twenty-seven M of chapter one hundred and eleven of the General Laws is hereby repealed.

Chap. 616. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF QUINCY TO PAY UNIFORM ALLOWANCES DIRECTLY TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF ITS POLICE, FIRE, HEALTH, AND HOSPITAL DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to the contrary, the city of Quincy may provide for the payment of uniform allowances directly to those employees of its police, fire, health and hospital departments who are entitled to such allowance.

SECTION 2. The city council of the city of Quincy may, by ordinance, provide for the direct payment to each employee of the unused portion of such employees' uniform allowance for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and seventy-five, to which such employee is entitled.

Chap. 617. AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE ENERGY FACILITIES SITING COUNCIL FOR THE REGULATION OF THE SITING, CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF ENERGY FACILITIES AND PROVIDING FOR RULES AND REGULATIONS AND REPORTING PROCEDURES TO THE SAID COUNCIL.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to regulate the siting of oil facilities within the commonwealth, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety, health and convenience.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 164 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 69G, as amended by section 1 of chapter 852 of the acts of 1974, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —
