AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT BY THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD OF CERTAIN COMPENSATION FOR ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES UPON THEIR RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The city of Pittsfield may provide that any employee of said
- 2 city who upon retirement has accumulated sick leave due him
- 3 shall be compensated for each day thereof, not to exceed 45
- 4 days, based on total accumulative sick leave of 90 days, at his
- 5 rate of pay immediately prior to his retirement.
