1 *Ordered*, That the joint committee on public safety be  
2 authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court to make  
3 an investigation and study of the subject matter of current House  
4 document 7730 relative to eliminating reciprocity on recreational  
5 and snow vehicles owned by non-residents.

6 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state  
7 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, and the production of  
8 books and papers, may travel within the commonwealth, and  
9 may expend for legal, clerical and other assistance and expenses  
10 such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall  
11 report to the General Court the results of its investigations and  
12 its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the  
13 Clerk of the House on or before the fourth Wednesday of  
14 December, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
