AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ACUSHNET TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCREASING AND IMPROVING ITS WATER SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of increasing and improving
2 the water system in the town of Acushnet, said town may
3 borrow, from time to time, such sums as may be necessary not
4 exceeding in the aggregate, two million five hundred thousand
5 dollars and may issue bonds or notes which shall bear on their
6 face the words, Asuchnet Water System Improvement Loan of
7 1973. Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and
8 such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty-five years from
9 their dates. Said improvements shall include but shall not be
10 limited to the installation of water mains and of eight inch pipes
11 or less and sixteen inch pipes or less.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
