AN ACT PROVIDING THAT JOSEPH FRECHETTE SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT AS A POLICE OFFICER IN THE CITY OF NEWTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The division of civil service shall certify for
2 appointment and the appointing authority of the city of Newton
3 may appoint Joseph Frechette to the police force in said city,
4 notwithstanding the fact that he fails to meet the height
5 requirement for said position, provided he passes all other
6 physical requirements.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
