RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A  
SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO CREATING A COMMISSION FOR  
THE DEAF.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-  
2 bers of the senate, five members of the house of representatives,  
3 the commissioner of the department of public health or his desig-  
4 nee, the commissioner of labor and industries or his designee, the  
5 commissioner of education or his designee, the commissioner of  
6 the massachusetts rehabilitation commission and four members to  
7 be appointed by the governor is hereby established for the pur-  
8 pose of making an investigation and study of current house docu-  
9 ment numbered 1597, relative to creating a commission for the  
10 deaf. Said commission shall report to the general court the results  
11 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, by  
12 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or  
13 before the third Wednesday of April, nineteen hundred and  
14 seventy-four.
