## MGC seeks public comment on Mass Gaming & Entertainment, LLC's resort-casino proposal in Brockton

From its inception, MGC has committed to ensuring an open, transparent and participatory process. To that end, there will be three primary opportunities for interested parties to offer comment to the Commission about the pending gaming application.

**Public Input Meeting:** Second, the MGC will convene a public input meeting in a community (Holbrook) adjacent to the proposed host community of the resort-casino proposal. The MGC respectfully requests that speakers either reside in or have a direct affiliation with the host community or one of the potential surrounding communities to the particular applicant.
