Chap. 725. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DETERMINATION OF THE COST OF CERTAIN COMBINED WATER TREATMENT FACILITIES BY THE DIVISION OF WATER POLLUTION CONTROL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 14 of chapter 546 of the acts of 1973 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

In determining the costs of projects approved between October eighteenth, nineteen hundred and seventy-two and March first, nineteen hundred and seventy-three which will have a combined sludge-solid waste incineration system, said division shall include in the eligible costs of the project an amount equal to the estimated cost of a separate sludge incinerator. Said estimated cost shall be prepared and certified by a registered professional engineer, and approved by the director of said division.

Chap. 726. AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRUSTEES OF THE BERKSHIRE ATHENAEUM.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 129 of the acts of 1871 is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence, added by section 1 of chapter 163 of the acts of 1897.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 129 is hereby further amended by striking out section 4, as amended by section 2 of said chapter 163, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

Section 4. There shall be nine trustees, consisting of the mayor, the president of the city council, the member of the school committee selected to serve as chairman in the absence of the mayor, and the treasurer of the city of Pittsfield, and their successors, who shall be ex officio trustees of the Berkshire Athenaeum during their terms of office, with the same power of voting and of participating in the management of said corporation as the other trustees, who shall be five persons to be appointed by the mayor of said city subject to confirmation by said city council, who shall be appointed for terms of one, two, three, four, and five years respectively and their successors for a term of five years.
