AN ACT AUTHORIZING A CREDIT UNION TO CHANGE THE LOCATION OF ITS BANKING OFFICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 171 of the General Laws is hereby amended by add-
- 2 ing after section 21 the following new section: —
- 3 *Section 21A.* A credit union may upon a two-thirds vote of
- 4 the members present and voting at an annual meeting or a
- 5 special meeting called for the purpose and with the approval
- 6 of the commissioner of banks change the location of its office.
