

or to inspect amusement devices shall, at least thirty days prior to such date, be sent to the holder of the certificate. The inspector of the division for the town where a holder of the certificate resides may issue a renewal certificate. A person whose certificate of competency is suspended or revoked shall surrender his certificate to the chief or an inspector of the division.

**Chap. 749. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR SUPERINTENDENTS OF RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH.**

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to forthwith broaden the qualifications for new superintendents of residential facilities of the department of mental health, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 14C of chapter 19 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 888 of the acts of 1970, is hereby amended by striking out the first two sentences and inserting in place thereof the following two sentences: — When a vacancy occurs in the position of superintendent of a state hospital or state school or director or other head of any residential mental health or mental retardation facility of the department, the commissioner shall appoint to such a vacancy a person who holds an earned doctoral degree or master's degree from an accredited college or university in a discipline appropriate to the care, treatment or education of the mentally ill or mentally retarded. Any person receiving such appointment shall have had at least four years of administrative or clinical experience in the field of mental illness or mental retardation or equivalent experience as determined by the commissioner.

**Chap. 750. AN ACT AMENDING CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE LAWS.**
