## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE GAME COMMONLY KNOWN AS FASCINATION SHALL CONSTITUTE A LOTTERY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 271 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 6B, inserted by chapter 243 of the acts of  
3 1953, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

4 *Section 6B.* Whoever sets up or promotes the game commonly  
5 known as skilo, fascination or any similar game regardless of  
6 name, shall be held to have set up and promoted a lottery  
7 and shall be punished as provided in section seven.
