AN ACT AUTHORIZING A MONTHLY TRANSPORTATION ALLOWANCE UNDER THE OLD AGE ASSISTANCE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The third paragraph of section 1 of chapter 118A of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 728 of the
3 acts of 1955, is hereby further amended by striking out in the
4 fourth line the words inserted by said chapter 728 "two dollars
5 and fifty cents" and inserting in place thereof the words:—
6 five dollars.
