## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.

AN ACT DESIGNATING CERTAIN BRIDGES IN THE TOWN OF BRAINTREE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The three level bridge at the intersection of  
2 Routes 3 and 128 in the town of Braintree shall be known and  
3 designated as the \_\_\_\_\_ bridge; the bridge on  
4 Washington street, Route 128, in said town shall be known and  
5 designated as Capen's bridge; the bridge at the corner of Pearl  
6 and Middle streets, Route 128, in said town shall be known and  
7 designated as the \_\_\_\_\_ bridge; the two bridges  
8 on Union street, Route 128, in said town shall be known and  
9 designated as the \_\_\_\_\_ bridge and the  
10 bridge, respectively; the bridge on Elm street, Route 128, in  
11 said town shall be known and designated as the \_\_\_\_\_  
12 bridge; and the bridge on Granite street, Route 128, in said  
13 town shall be known and designated as the \_\_\_\_\_  
14 bridge. Suitable markers bearing said designations shall be  
15 erected and maintained on said bridges by the department of  
16 public works.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
