## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE COMMONWEALTH TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO CITIES AND TOWNS UP TO ONE THIRD OF THE COST OF URBAN RENEWAL PROJECTS WHICH ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FEDERAL AID.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The first paragraph of section 26BBB of chapter 121 of the
- 2 General Laws, as appearing in section 4 of chapter 654 of the
- 3 acts of 1955, is hereby amended by adding at the end the follow-
- 4 ing sentence:— The commonwealth is authorized to grant to
- 5 a city or town an amount equal to one third the cost of a project
- 6 which is not eligible for federal aid.
