AN ACT TO CORRECT CERTAIN INEQUITIES IN THE MOTOR VEHICLE  
EXCISE TAX LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows.*

1 The first paragraph of section 1 of chapter 60A of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out in the last sentence the  
3 words "and succeeding years" and substituting the word: —  
4 year, — then adding four more sentences, as follows: —

In the sixth year . . . . .	8%
In the seventh year . . . . .	6%
In the eighth year . . . . .	4%
In the ninth and succeeding years . . . . .	2%
