AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE WIDENING OF CERTAIN THOROUGHFARES  
IN HYDE PARK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is hereby au-  
2 thorized and directed to widen River street in Hyde Park from  
3 Cleary square to Logan square and Fairmount avenue in Hyde  
4 Park from Logan square to Pierce street.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act, said department  
2 may expend such sums as may hereafter be appropriated therefor.

The House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, and of the Commonwealth the hundred and thirty-eighth, have passed the following Act, to-wit:

**AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN PHOTOGRAPHS BY STATE POLICE.**

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The department of public works is hereby authorized and directed to withdraw from public view all photographs taken in the department of public works and to deposit the same in the files of the department.

**SECTION 2.** For the purpose of this act, and department of public works is hereby authorized to deposit the same in the files of the department.
