AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NOTIFICATION TO LICENSED AGENTS AND BROKERS OF ORIGINAL OR AMENDED FILINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting the following new section:—
- 3 *Section 193F.* The insurance commissioner shall maintain
- 4 in his office a list of licensed agents and brokers who express a
- 5 desire to be notified of any original filings or amended filings
- 6 affecting manual, minimum and class rates, rating schedules
- 7 or rating plans, and an annual fee of five dollars shall be charged
- 8 to each such agent and broker for said listings. The insurance
- 9 commissioner shall be required to notify such agents and brokers
- 10 whenever such a filing is made, and shall further be required
- 11 to provide that such agents and brokers may receive the complete
- 12 text of any such filing upon request and upon payment to the
- 13 insurance commissioner such sum as he may determine to defray
- 14 the costs of preparing such copy.
