AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TRUSTEES OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO FIX RATES OF FARE UPON THE BASIS OF DISTANCE TRAVELED BY THE PASSENGER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
