AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DECORATION OF VETERANS' GRAVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of chapter 115 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 143 of the acts of 1957, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the last sentence thereof and inserting
4 the following: — The city or town in which the deceased veteran
5 is buried shall cause to be placed on his grave, a flag of the
6 United States on every Memorial day.
