

HOUSE No. 1057

By Mr. Hull of Rockport, petition of Richard L. Hull that veterans in the service of cities and towns be authorized to select retirement under the contributory system or the Veterans Retirement Act. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT ALLOWING ANY CITY OR TOWN EMPLOYEE, WHO IS A VETERAN AND A MEMBER OF THE CONTRIBUTORY SYSTEM, TO ELECT EITHER THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT ACT OR THE VETERANS ACT TO BE RETIRED UNDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A veteran, as defined in section one of chapter 32
2 of the General Laws, who is an employee of any city or town,
3 and also a member of the contributory retirement system, may,
4 upon becoming eligible for retirement, elect either the contribu-
5 tory retirement act or the veterans act, to be retired under.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
