Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good,
- 2 the town of Wellesley is hereby authorized to pay William
- 3 O'Donoghue, an assistant superintendent in the department of
- 4 public works of said town, who was employed by the town as a
- 5 laborer and a foreman for over twenty-five years before being
- 6 promoted to his present position, upon his retirement the pen-
- 7 sion to which he would have been entitled under section seventy-
- 8 seven or seventy-seven A of chapter thirty-two of the General
- 9 Laws as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition if he had con-
- 10 tinued to be employed as such a foreman until that time.
- 1 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon acceptance by
- 2 the town of Wellesley by a vote at a town meeting duly called
