AN ACT AFFECTING THE PAYMENT OF OPTIONS IN THE CONTRIBUTORY AND NON-CONTRIBUTORY PENSION SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 the following section:—

3 *Section 99.* Any member of the contributory, or non-contribu-
4 tory pension system, retired under the provisions of any option
5 other than option A shall, upon the death of his wife, or other
6 named beneficiary, receive as his pension the amount he would
7 have received had he retired under the provisions of option A.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in Assembly, on the 15th day of February, in the year one thousand nine hundred and six.

1. Chapter 23 of the General Laws hereby amended by adding the following section:—

2. Section 23, after reading of the constitution, in amendment to the provisions therein relating to the position of any officer or other than section 2 shall, upon the death of his wife or other female descendant, provide as his position the same as would be provided had he retired under the provisions of section 2.
