AN ACT REQUIRING CRUISER CARS OPERATED BY POLICE DEPARTMENTS TO BE EQUIPPED WITH SUITABLE FORCIBLE ENTRY TOOLS AND GAS MASKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 All city and town police departments maintaining cruiser
- 2 service shall have each cruiser equipped with a suitable forcible
- 3 entry tool and one or more suitable all-purpose gas masks.
