AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE MASSACHUSETTS AERONAUTICS COMMISSION TO PURCHASE A TWIN-ENGINE AIRPLANE FOR STATE EXECUTIVES AND DEPARTMENTAL USE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Massachusetts aeronautics commission is hereby au-
2 thorized to purchase a twin-engine airplane for use by state
3 executives while traveling on official business for the common-
4 wealth and for departmental business. The commission may
5 expend for such purpose, such sums as may be appropriated
6 therefor.
