AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF MARLBOROUGH AND PROVIDING THAT HE SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME TO HIS JUDICIAL DUTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 77A of chapter 218
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 line reading "first district court of northern Middlesex", as
4 appearing in section 1 of chapter 675 of the acts of 1958, the
5 following line: — district court of Marlborough.

1 SECTION 2. Section 78 of said chapter 218 is hereby amended
2 by striking out, in line 20 as appearing in section 2 of said chapter
3 675, the words "district court of Marlborough,".

The Constitution of Massachusetts

As Amended by the People of the Commonwealth

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, IN RELATION TO THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, AND TO REVISE THE CONSTITUTION IN RELATION TO THE JUDICIAL BRANCH.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in their respective and joint sessions, on the _____ day of _____, 19____.

Section 1. The first paragraph of section 77A of chapter 77 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the words "first chief justice of superior judicial," as appearing in section 1 of chapter 67B of the acts of 1932, the following:— "district court of Marlborough."

Section 2. Section 78 of said chapter 77 is hereby amended by striking out, in the 30th appearing in section 2 of said chapter 77, the words "district court of Marlborough."
